## Water Storage Tank Rehabilitation

### Hunting Hill Tank

**Project Description:** The City of Rockville's contractor, *Horizon Brothers Painting Corp.*, will make repairs to the Hunting Hill water storage tank beginning in February. Construction will last approximately six months.

During construction, construction vehicles, equipment, materials, and personnel will access the project area. There will be minimal impact on vehicular traffic. Detailed information about the project is available at [www.rockvillemd.gov/watertankrehab](http://www.rockvillemd.gov/watertankrehab)

**Purpose:** City staff worked with an engineering firm to design recommended improvements to the Hunting Hill and Carr Avenue water storage tanks, including safety upgrades, repairs, replacement of the steel roof supports, interior and exterior work to remove existing paint, and check for lead and repaint. While both tanks were reconditioned 10 years ago and lead paint is not expected to be present, the Environmental Protection Agency requires lead testing and lead safety precautions.

This project is included in the Mayor and Council's adopted Fiscal Year 2017 Capital Improvements Program.

**Location:** 13890 Glen Mill Road.

**Timeline:** Construction is scheduled to begin in February 2017 and continue for approximately six months.

**Cost:** Approximately \$3 million (for rehabilitation of both Hunting Hill and Carr Avenue tanks).
