

# Town Center Nighttime Sewer Maintenance Construction Scheduled

**Project Description:** The City of Rockville has historically experienced a series of sewer backups in the downtown area. These backups are frequently related to improper disposal of oil and grease down the drain from residential and commercial properties.

To correct this situation, the city intends to perform preventive maintenance by flushing the sewers. Since the problem areas are in Town Center/downtown, the work will be performed from 10 p.m. - 6 a.m. to avoid congestion and traffic delays. This work is scheduled to begin on Sunday, May 14, and run through Friday, May 19.

This work will use lights and create vehicular noise. Work will be temporary at any given location and will move on once maintenance is completed at each site.

Asphalt repairs also will be done on Hungerford Drive at Beall Avenue and 26 W. Jefferson Street.

**Purpose:** To help prevent sewer backups and to eliminate failing asphalt patches.

**Location:** North Washington Street, from Hungerford Drive to West Jefferson Street. Beall Avenue, between North Washington Street and Hungerford Drive. All of Gibbs Street. Maryland Avenue, between Beall and East Jefferson Street. Middle Lane, between Hungerford Drive and North Washington Street. East Montgomery Avenue. Monroe Street, between East Middle Lane to East Jefferson Street and Monroe Place.

**Timeline:** Construction is scheduled to begin during the week of May 14-19.
