Construction Advisory Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation

Project Description:

The Department of Public Works' contractor, AM-Liner East, Inc., will repair a sanitary sewer main in your neighborhood the week of June 5th.

The repair involves installing a liner along the interior of the sewer pipe to seal cracks, address defects and help prevent root intrusion. Excavation is not needed because the liner is installed through existing manholes. AM-Liner will access manholes behind your home and drive vehicles in the work areas. Because the sewer pipe will be temporarily out of service, it will be necessary to reroute the sewer flow. The contractor may set up temporary leak-proof hoses and pumps to reroute the flow. You may see these hoses and you may hear the portable pumps.

Temporary lane closures and parking restrictions may be necessary. Residents will be asked to refrain from using water during specific hours while the work is being performed. AM-Liner will place notices on the front doors of affected residences two business days before work begins. Notices will include instructions on how to limit your water use on the day work occurs and will provide contact information to use if you experience problems.

Rehabilitation of a damaged sanitary sewer main.

The rear yards of 605 - 707 Harrington Road. (See the map on the reverse side of this

advisory.)

Timeline:

The week of June 5th. Repairs are expected to take one day to complete, weather

permitting.
