Rose Hill and Rose Hill Falls Hydrant Painting

Project Description: The City is phasing in the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) standard for fire hydrant color coding. Volunteers will be in your neighborhood to paint 39 City fire hydrants on Saturday, May 12 and Sunday, May 13 between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. The hydrants will be painted safety yellow with the appropriate bonnet color to signify the hydrant's applicable flow rate. Eventually, all City fire hydrants will be painted to the NFPA standard.

Purpose: To paint all City fire hydrants yellow to meet the NFPA standard.

Location: Rose Hill and Rose Hill Falls.

Timeline: Painting will occur on Saturday, May 12 and Sunday, May 13 between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. If volunteers are unable to complete the work due to inclement weather, the work will be rescheduled.
