Motion: The Board finds that Mr. Lee's campaign violated Sections 874A and 875A of the Municipal Code of Rockville by paying his campaign expenses with his personal funds, rather than his campaign depository.

Motion: The Board Chair will work with staff to issue a letter to Mr. Lee identifying the violation, but not assessing or issuing a citation for a municipal infraction.

Motion: The Board Chair will work with staff to issue a letter to Mr. Lee explaining that all campaign documents should be submitted through the proper channels.

Moved by Boardmember Orlosky, seconded by Boardmember Fisher, and approved unanimously.

Boardmember Orlosky reported on the activities the State legislature is in recess; the State is looking to shift the financial burden of managing poll books to the County level.
