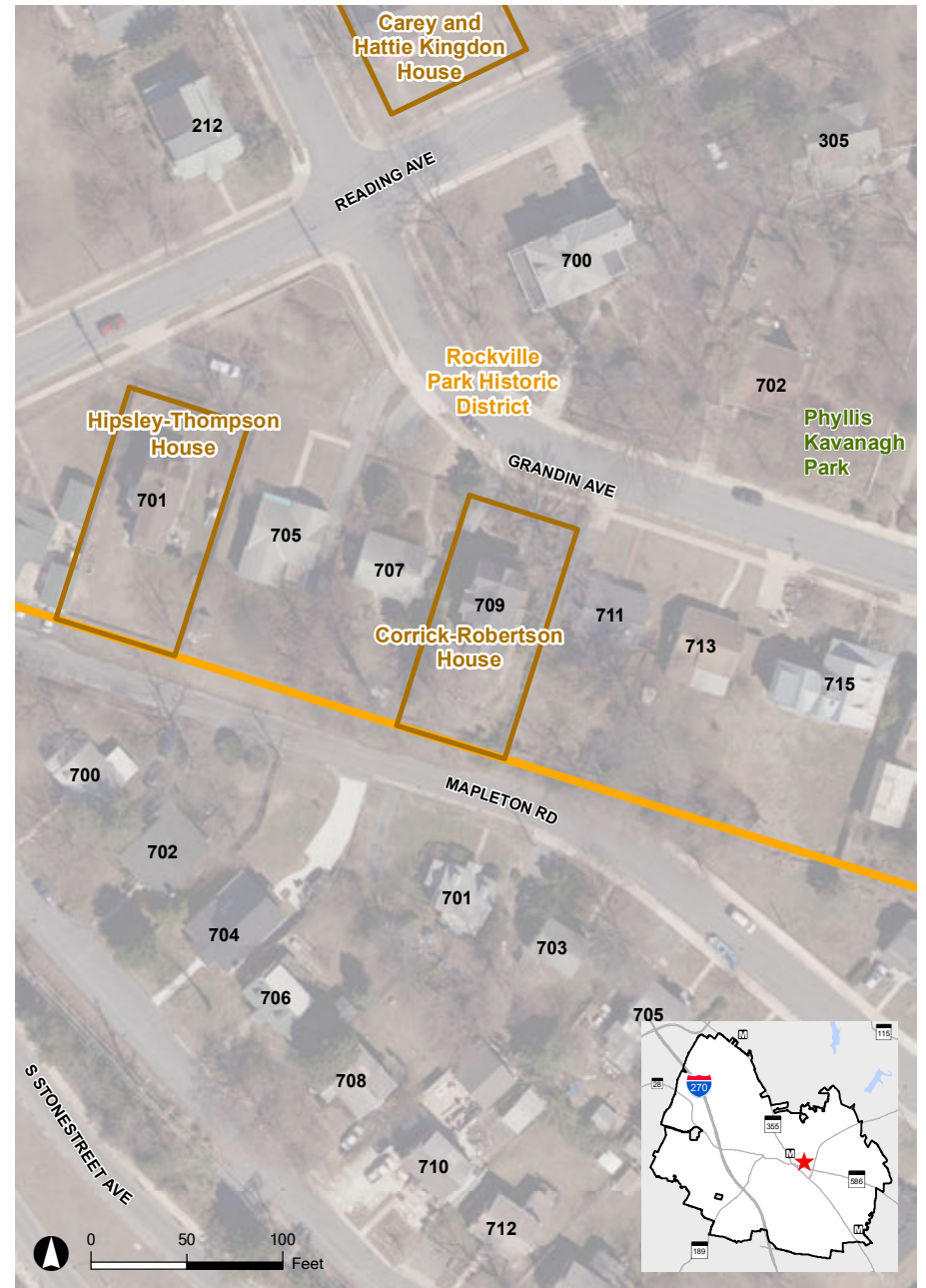


Corrick-Robertson House

The Corrick-Robertson house is a Victorian Gothic Revival style house constructed in 1893. notable features include the prominent front gable, the two-story side bay with a polygonal first floor and a square bay above, and floor-to-ceiling windows at the front parlor. This was one of the early homes built in the Rockville. The Robertsons purchased the property in 1927 and lived here for many years.
