

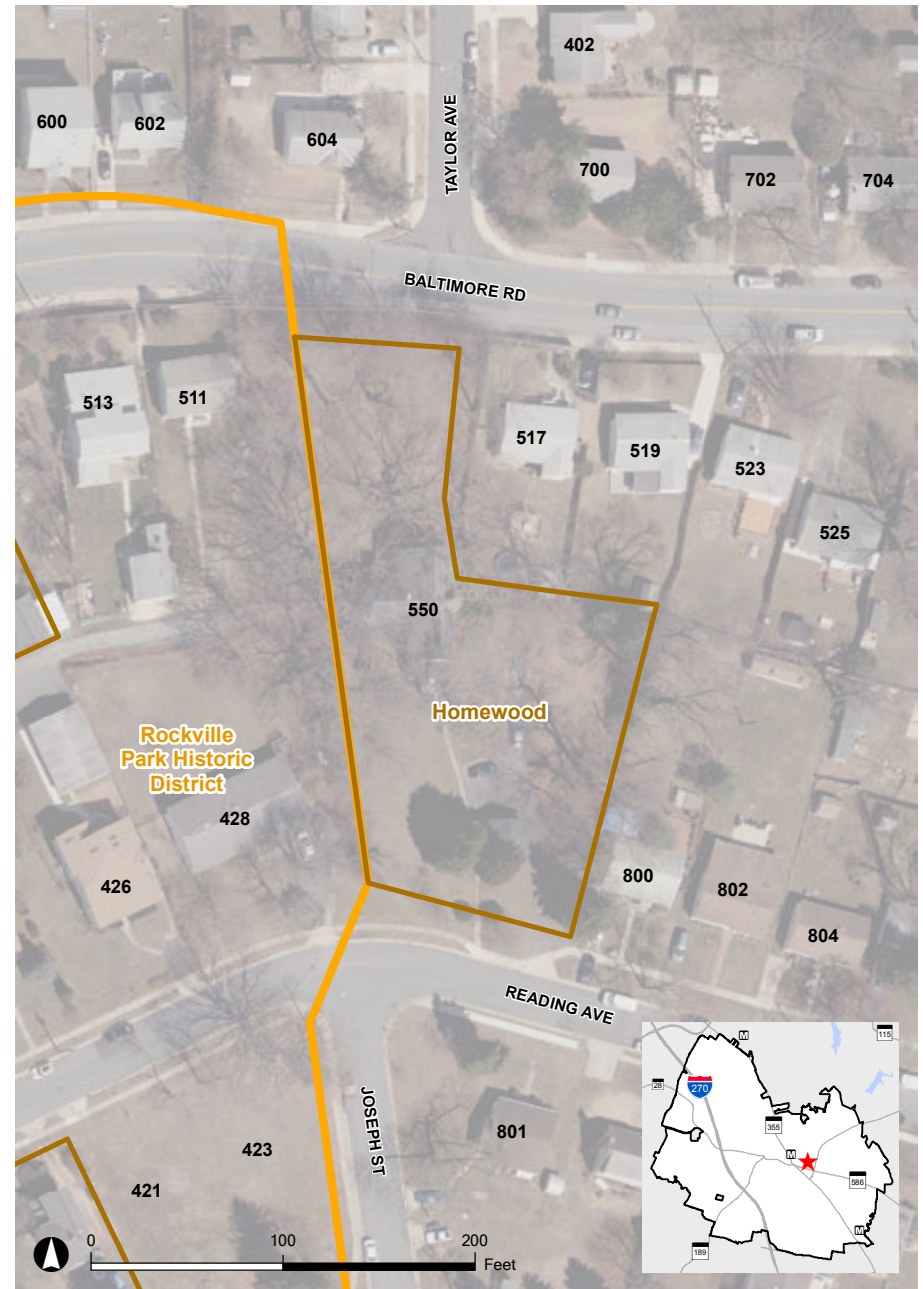
Homewood

550 Reading Avenue



Homewood was built for Addie and John Maddox ca. 1898. The Maddox family was locally prominent in the Town of Rockville, where John's father Dr. Charles J. Maddox, was a well-known physician. This property, spanning between Baltimore Road and Reading Road, was part of a parcel of land inherited by John's stepmother, Catherine Jane Harding Maddox. The 1887 subdivision, Janeta, is a reflection of her middle name.

The house is a late Victorian country home, with the main portion and side wing reflecting the Victorian ideal of extension into the landscape. The original property has been largely preserved, with many mature trees and extensive lawn around the house.
