

Steinberg House

110 South Adams Street



The Steinberg House, constructed in 1929, is an American Foursquare with square form, hipped roof with wide flared eaves, and 3/1 windows. The foundation uses ston-faced concrete blocks, a typical early 20th century material. The Steinbergs, reputedly Rockville's first Jewish family, were important retailers in downtown Rockville for over 50 years.
