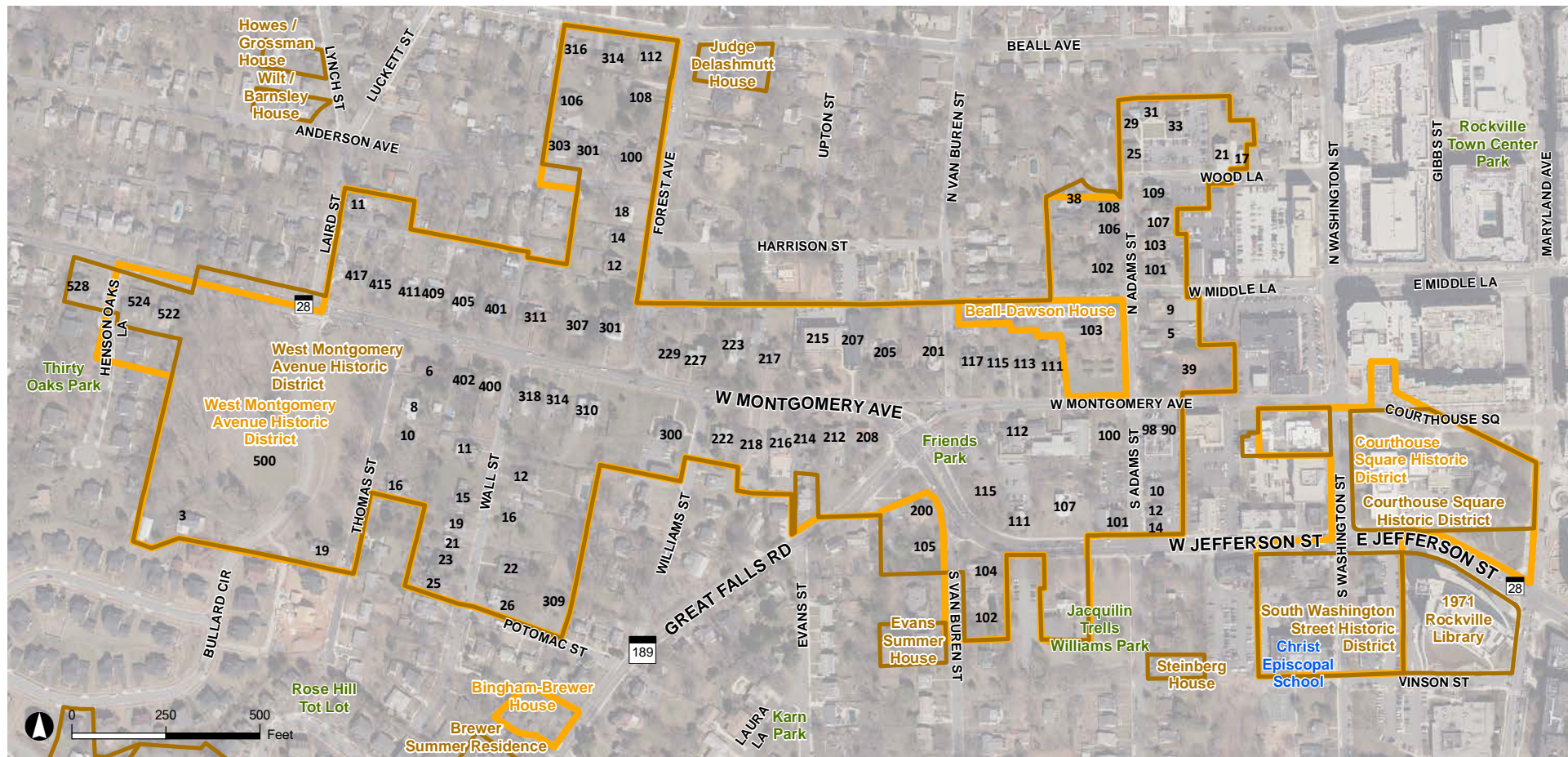


West Montgomery Avenue Historic District

The West Montgomery Avenue Historic District includes major elements of the late 19th century Town of Rockville, including residential neighborhoods, local churches, an associated church cemetery, educational facilities (Rockville Academy), and the early hotel property that became a nationally-recognized psychiatric hospital (Chesnut Lodge). The district extends north and south along the spine of West Montgomery Avenue, and includes a fine collection of Victorian frame homes as well as a few earlier mid-19th century homes. In 1975, much of the district was listed in the National Register of Historic Places and the Beall-Dawson House, located within the district, was listed individually in the National Register in 1973.
