PREPARING FOR HALLOWEEN, PART 4

Since October is just a long wait for Halloween, this month we'll highlight one set of Halloween tips per week. This week, we're reminding you to consider these last few things after a night of Trick-or-Treating:

- Remind children **not to eat any treats until they come home.**
- **Avoid homemade treats** and only eat factory-wrapped candy.
- Remove your child's makeup soon after trick-or-treating to avoid skin irritation.
- **Parents should check all treats at home in a well-lit place.** Although incidents of tainted candy are very rare, be sure to inspect treats for any allergens and discard any items with damaged wrapping and anything not in its original packaging
