REPORTING DOWNED CABLE LINES

If you encounter a communication line hanging down, exposed or out of the ground, or if a pedestal or cable junction box is open, has exposed wires, or is a tripping hazard, you may submit a service request to the Montgomery County Community Technology Office.

Telephone or cable lines can become energized. **Do not attempt to move, relocate, cut or otherwise come in close contact with these wires** unless you have verified they are non-energized through a voltage tester or detector.

Keep yourself and others away and avoid touching anything that may be in contact with the line.

If feasible, **protect the area by placing cones or other barriers around the line to alert pedestrians** and submit a complaint by clicking the "Create Service Request" button at this provided link: [Montgomery County, MD 311 - Answering to You \(montgomerycountymd.gov\)](https://montgomerycountymd.gov/311-answering-to-you)

In some cases, on-line service requests will be reviewed the next business day.
